

## MEIGS COUNTY REPUBLICAN MEETING

AUGUST 14, 2012

The Meigs County Republican Party met at 6:30 PM on August 14, 2012 in the basement of the Meigs County Courthouse due to a scheduling conflict in the courtroom.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Melvin Holmes. Minutes of the previous meeting were read by Secretary Deloris Grissom; Motion to approve the minutes was made by Bob Lamb and seconded by R.J. Gryder. An oral vote to approve was taken and there were no dissenting votes.

Chairman Holmes asked for opinions and desires of the party and R.J. Gryder said he would like for us to form a Young Republican Club, get more republicans to the poles to vote and appoint district committees. These were discussed among those present.

Newly elected Property Assessor Billy Breeden was recognized and asked if he wanted to comment. Billy thanked everyone for the help and support that he received during the election. Candidate for Meigs Road Supervisor Jerry Shoemaker was recognized and asked to comment. He gave his qualifications and asked for the support of the Republican Party.

Alan Frye, Treasurer gave a financial report. We had a beginning balance of \$880.87 received \$0.15 interest and paid Piggly Wiggly \$91.20 for ½ the cost of sandwiches that were delivered to poll workers on election day leaving a balance on hand of \$789.82 Motion to accept the report was made by Deloris Grissom and seconded by Bob Lamb. An oral vote to approve was taken and there were no dissenting votes.

A financial report of the money collect by concerned republicans was given by Deloris Grissom. There was a beginning balance of \$255.00 less expense of \$51.57 for watermelon cuttings leaving a balance of \$203.43. A motion was made by Connie Allen and seconded by Billy Breeden to all the balance of \$203.43 to the

party treasury. An oral vote to approve was taken and there were no dissenting votes.

The money, copy of all receipts and the financial report were turned over to Alan Frye, Treasurer.

There were discussions concerning ways to contact Republican voters, fund raisers, and a booth at the County Fair September 6 – 8<sup>th</sup> from 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM. Inquiries are to be made and an email advising if we are moving forward with this project.

A motion to adjourn was made by Alan Wade, and seconded Billy Breeden. An oral vote to approve was taken and there were no dissenting votes.
